

## **Recyclable Materials**

Paper: cardboard, cardboard tubes, corrugated cardboard, matting, puzzle pieces, milk cartons, shredded paper, construction paper scraps, paper bags, sandpaper, newspaper, wrapping paper, wallpaper, empty match boxes, catalogs, file folders

Metal: metal wire, chains, pipes, mechanical gears, mesh, miscellaneous hardware, frozen juice lids

Wood: blocks, cork, plywood, wicker, puzzle pieces, clothespins

Cordage: rope, string, laces, jute

Leather: pieces, cord

Glass-Mirrors-Plexiglass: sheets, containers, pendants, balls, polycarbonates, baby food jars
